states and a commitment to international peace and internationally agreed-upon mechanisms for the resolution of conflicts based on a multilateral approach.

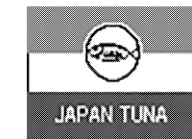
In this regard, we call upon the international community to join us in commemorating this milestone and partner with us as we strengthen our constitutional democracy going forward.

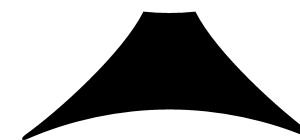

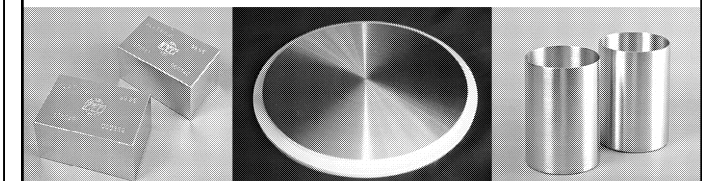
