
Morocco at forefront of COVID-19 response

Over the past year, the COVID-19 pandemic has demonstrated that multilateral cooperation is essential to overcome the challenges facing the world. In this regard, Morocco's strategy against COVID-19 has been marked by active solidarity towards Africa. This approach comes within the framework of southsouth cooperation, one of the pillars of the Kingdom's diplomacy. Thus, upon the instructions of HM King Mohammed VI, Morocco dispatched medical assistance to 20 African countries to support their efforts in fighting the pandemic. Furthermore, the Kingdom launched on July 6 the first project for the fill-finish manufacturing of COVID-19 vaccine in Africa, making Morocco the leading biotechnology platform on the continent. As the first African country to launch its national vaccination campaign, Morocco also expressed its willingness to share its experience with African countries to support their vaccination efforts.

COVID-19 has also impacted the global economy. In this regard, Morocco has launched an ambitious economic recovery plan, with a budget of \$13.5 billion, equivalent to 11% of the country's gross domestic product (GDP). Its corner stone is the Mohammed VI Strategic Investment Fund, which is playing a leading role in fostering investment and national economy capacities. This plan places Morocco at the forefront in terms of post-crisis economic recovery

In May 2021, the Kingdom launched a New Development Model, which is a roadmap bringing together political parties, institutions and civil society in order to set up the new strategic development goals of the nation towards 2035. This model is a new phase in consolidating the social and economic policies in Morocco.

The Moroccan approach to sustainable development places active solidarity at the center of its priorities, in order to strengthen social cohesion and to boost the purchasing power of all Moroccans. Thus, HM King Mohammed VI launched in April 2021 the national plan for the generalization of social security to all Moroccans, including health insurance, pension schemes and family allowances.

Lastly, I would like to commend the excellence of the relations between Morocco and Japan, which have witnessed steadfast development on all levels. I am glad to note that over the past 10 years, the number of Japanese companies operating in Morocco has more than doubled, reaching 75 companies, making Morocco the second-largest destination for Japanese companies in Africa.
