According to the WHO, the number of cervical cancer deaths is expected to

increase worldwide from 311,000 to 400,000 between 2018 and 2030. Cervical cancer is also the leading cause of death among women in Uganda, Africa. Since 2012, Saraya has been supporting the "White Ribbon Campaign" through the NGO Japanese Organization for International Cooperation in Family Planning (JOICFP). Together, they helped protect pregnant and nursing mothers from infectious diseases through Phase 1 of the "SARAYA Safe Motherhood Project", with Saraya already starting Phase 2 of the project.


